Leveraging Digital Health for System-Level Impact

What the OpenEvidence vs Doximity Lawsuit teaches us about securing medical AI models in South Africa

A landmark 2025 U.S. lawsuit exposed how clinical AI models can be compromised through prompt injection and physician identity theft. This session examines the real-world security risks facing medical AI and why traditional compliance frameworks alone are not enough. Learn the key attack vectors, emerging AI security standards, and what South African healthcare organisations must do to protect clinical AI systems ahead of NHI and POPIA enforcement.

Architecting the fundamentals before the Technology

This session will explore the foundational capabilities required for successful digital health transformation, highlighting the importance of governance, information architecture, interoperability, master data management, enterprise workflows, and trust frameworks.
